Dear Secretary Pompeo:


I write to respectfully ask for your urgent assistance for my constituents who are currently stranded in Spain.

The severity of the current COVID-19 pandemic has made nations around the world implement stricter border controls and, in some cases, complete shutdowns to prevent an outbreak of the virus.

It has come to our attention that 6 American citizens originating from Puerto Rico are currently reported stranded in the city of Grenada. Their names are: Modesto Colón Cruz, Raquel Colón Cruz, Rafael Cruz López, Judith Felicie, Carmen M. Barreto and Carmen García.

It is due to the urgency of the situation that I request that in accordance with all applicable rules, laws and regulations, you take swift action in bringing these American citizens back home.
