I am requesting funding for the rehabilitation of the San Lorenzo Community Facility of the Boys & Girls Club of Puerto Rico in the municipality of San Lorenzo.

The entity that would receive funding for this project is the Boys & Girls Club of Puerto Rico (BGCP), located at 501 R.H. Todd Avenue, San Juan, Puerto Rico 00907.

The purpose of this funding is to cover expenses to rehabilitate a school acquired by the Boys & Girls Club in San Lorenzo to be their community facility or club site. This club has been operating for 13 years, and provides services in the municipalities of San Lorenzo, Juncos, Gurabo, Caguas, and Las Piedras. Specifically, funding would allow BGCP to connect the 4 buildings that make up school grounds, expand the entrance area with security improvements, resurface and reconfigure the courtyard between buildings, and complete safety and sustainability repairs to the building's infrastructure systems.
