I am requesting funding for Puerto Rico Highways and Transportation Authorities project #4 in the surface transportation reauthorization legislation.


The project sponsor is the Puerto Rico Highways and Transportation Authority and the project is located in the municipality of San Juan.

The funding is designated to improve Puerto Rico's Critical Freight and Commuter Connections along PR-17, PR-18, and PR-22 along the National Highway System.
